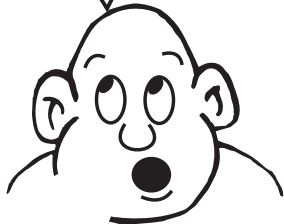

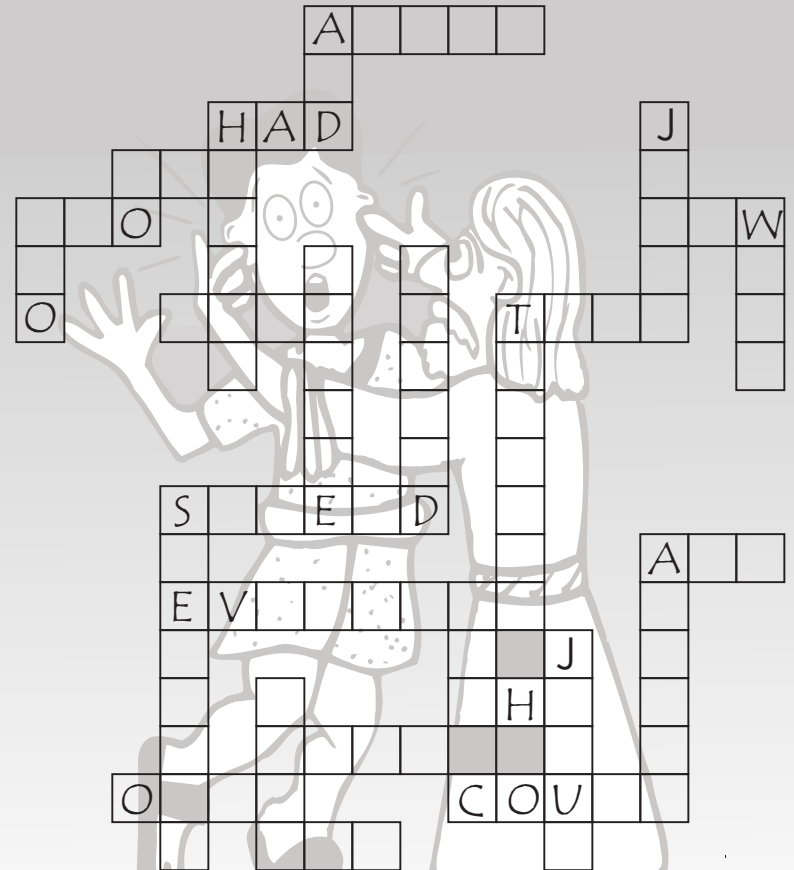

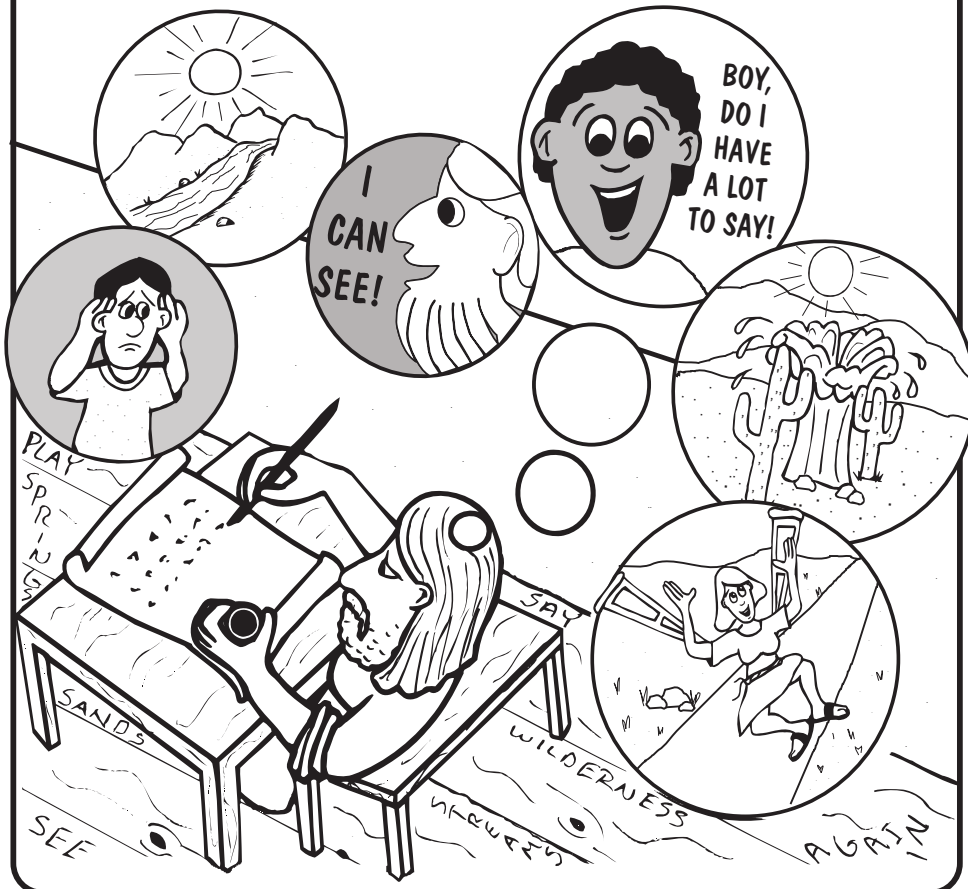
Jesus once healed a man who could not hear and had trouble speaking. The people who saw this were amazed, and spread the word about Jesus to everyone around them.
