Featuring African Music led by David English

Doug Tilton currently serves as regional liaison for Southern Africa, helping to strengthen the mutual ministries of the PC(USA) and its partner churches and institutions in five countries: Lesotho, Madagascar, Mozambique, South Africa and Zimbabwe. Doug also provides support for other PC(USA) mission personnel in the region, and helps to connect PC(USA) presbyteries and congregations with their counterparts in Southern Africa.

"Our church is changing, and so is our approach to mission and partnership," Doug writes. "One of the most dynamic developments of recent years has been the growth of direct presbytery and congregational links between the United States and other parts of the world. Another important development is the emergence of mission networks to enable those involved in partnerships to exchange experiences and insights and to learn from one another. Regional liaisons can assist these efforts by providing relevant information and analysis, facilitating communications, and troubleshooting problems."


SUMMER WORSHIP

Acts 2:1-21

Theme

Pentecost



- 1. What does the miracle of Pentecost mean to you? What thoughts, feelings, ideas or images come to mind as you consider this story in Acts?
- 2. Who have you met through Calvin who you would not have met otherwise? What does this connection mean to you? What do you think it means to them? To Calvin?
- 3. How might you build more connections at Calving or within your community? In what ways might you need to move outside your "comfort zone" to make these connections?

Affirmation of faith (The Confession of Belhar)

Apartheid is the human context for the Confession of Belhar, yet it is never mentioned in the confession. Rather, Belhar lifts up the heart of the Gospel as a bringer of hope for the human condition. Belhar presents a Christian view of racism, separation, and suffering by those who had experienced the realities of these evils. It demonstrates that confessional affirmations can arise from social ethics.

Belhar has three central points: Unity, Reconciliation, and Justice. It is structured like the Theological Declaration of Barmen.
