

I Samuel 16

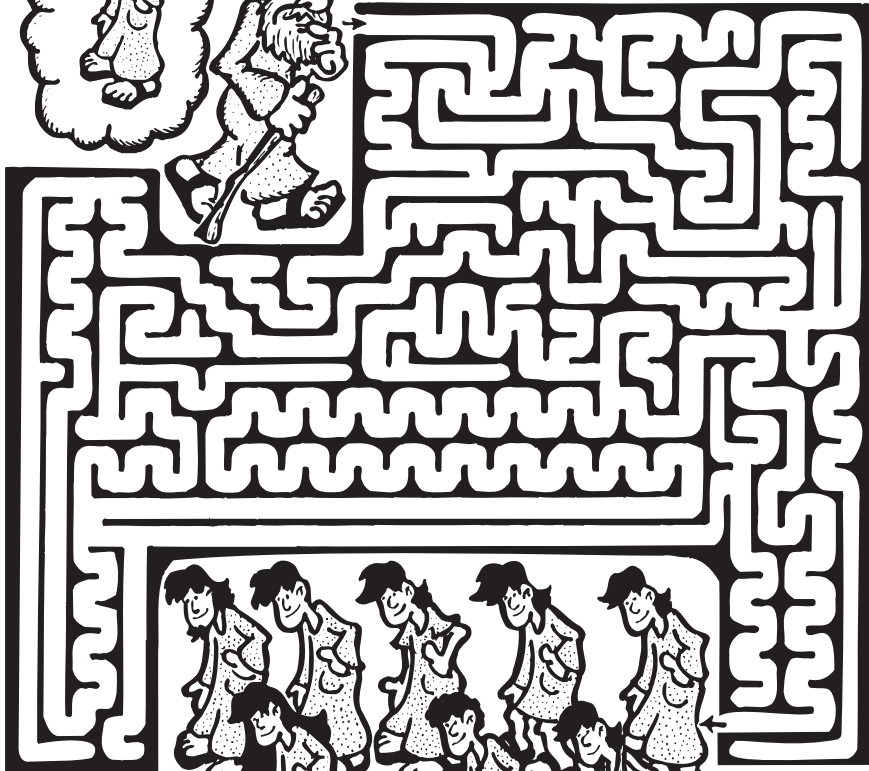
Saul, the king of God's people long ago, disobeyed the Lord and did wicked things. God decided that his people must have a new king.

Find the son that looks like the one Samuel has in mind.

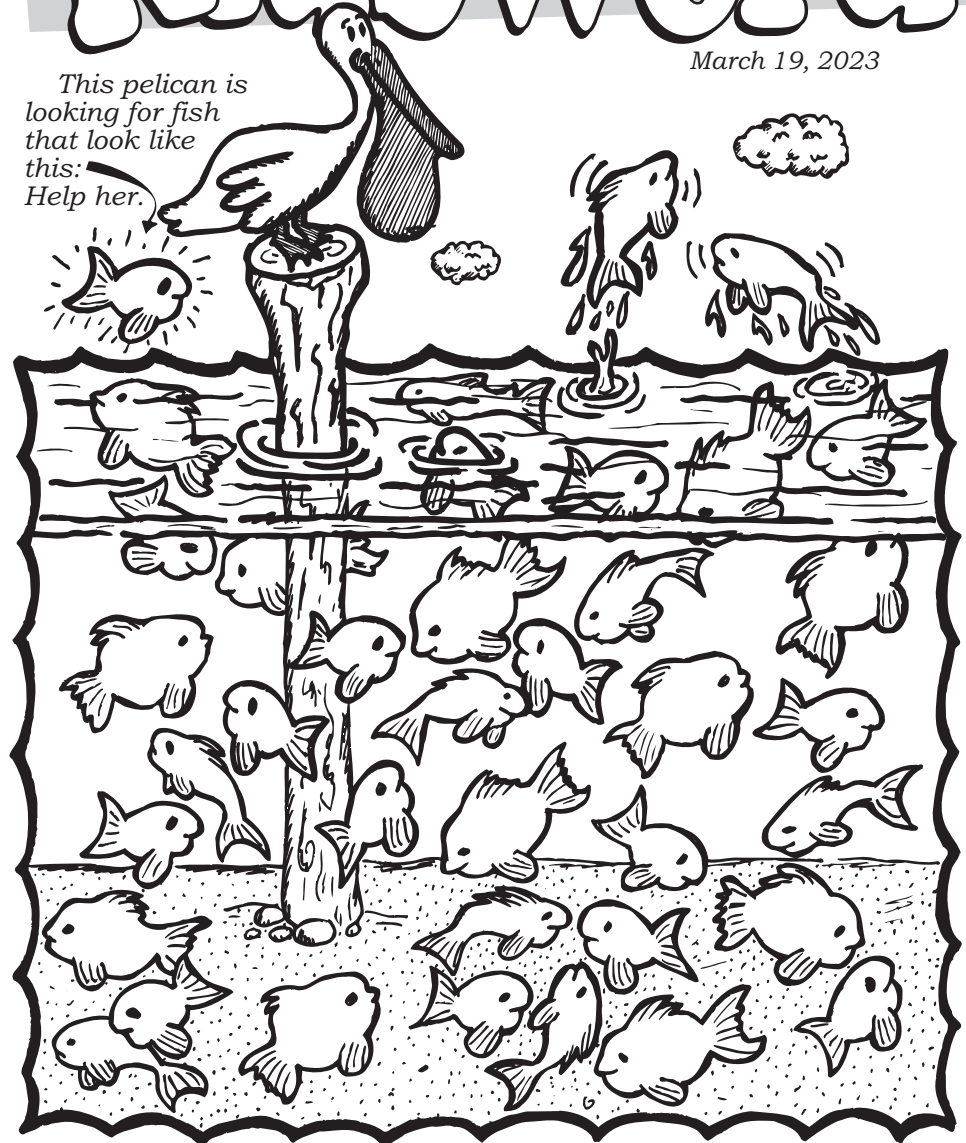

What did he say? Find his words in the word search and put them below.

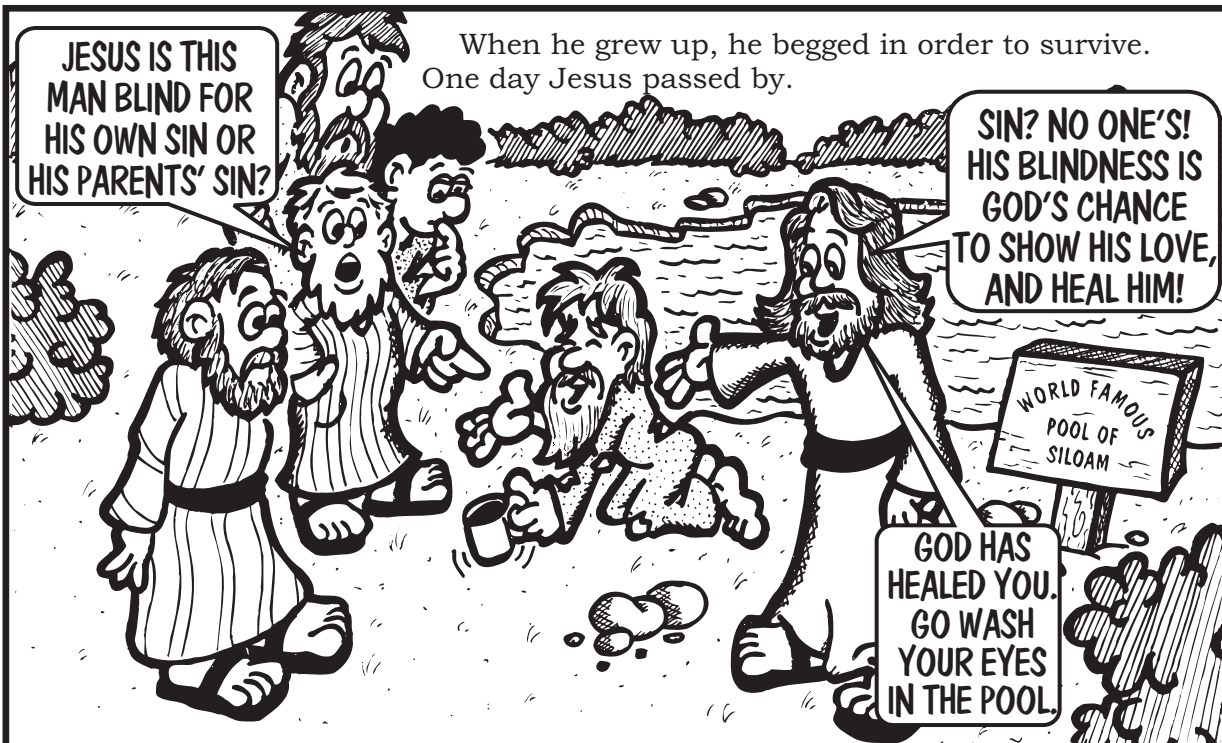

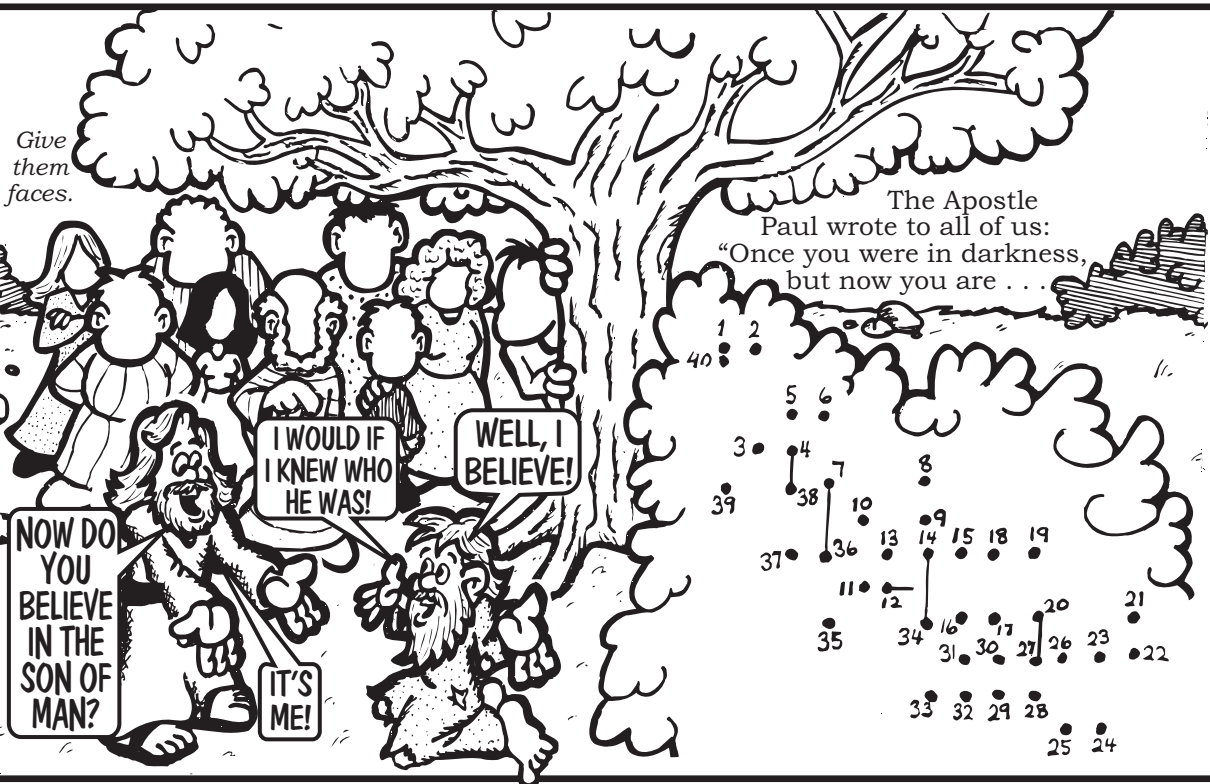
