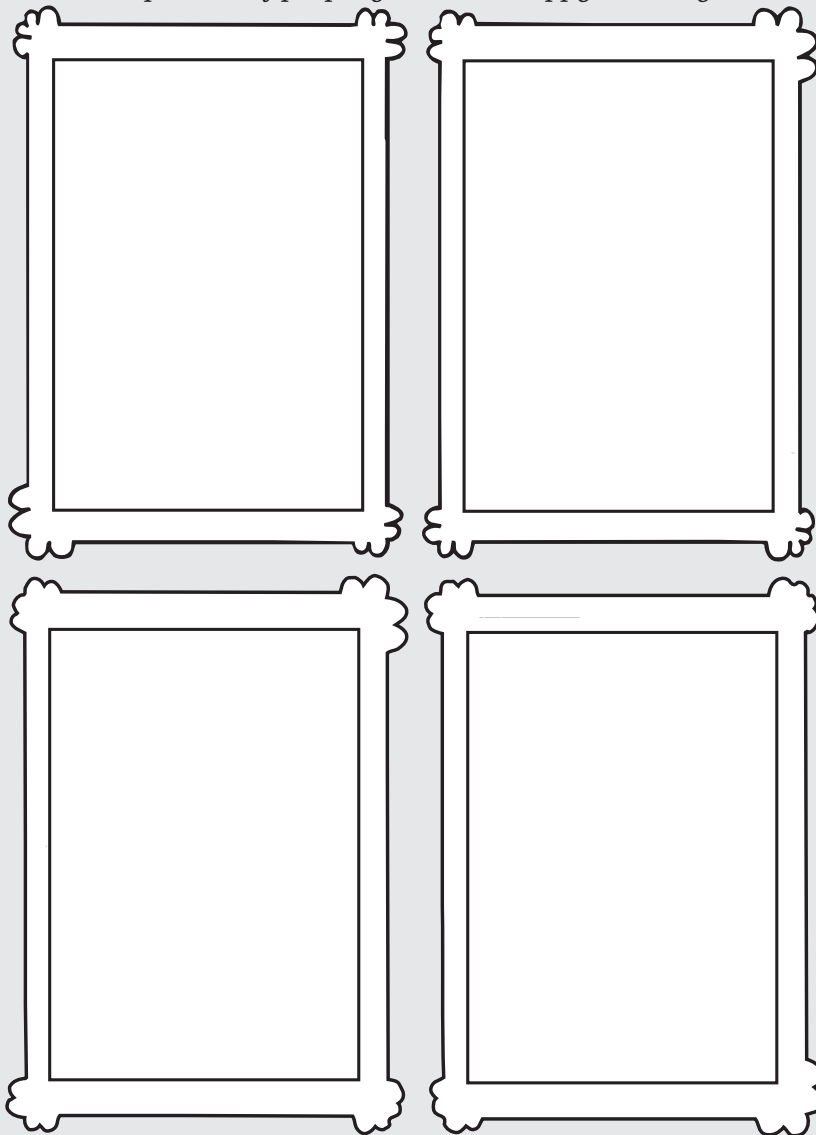


1 Thessalonians 4

*Draw pictures of people you will be happy to see again.*



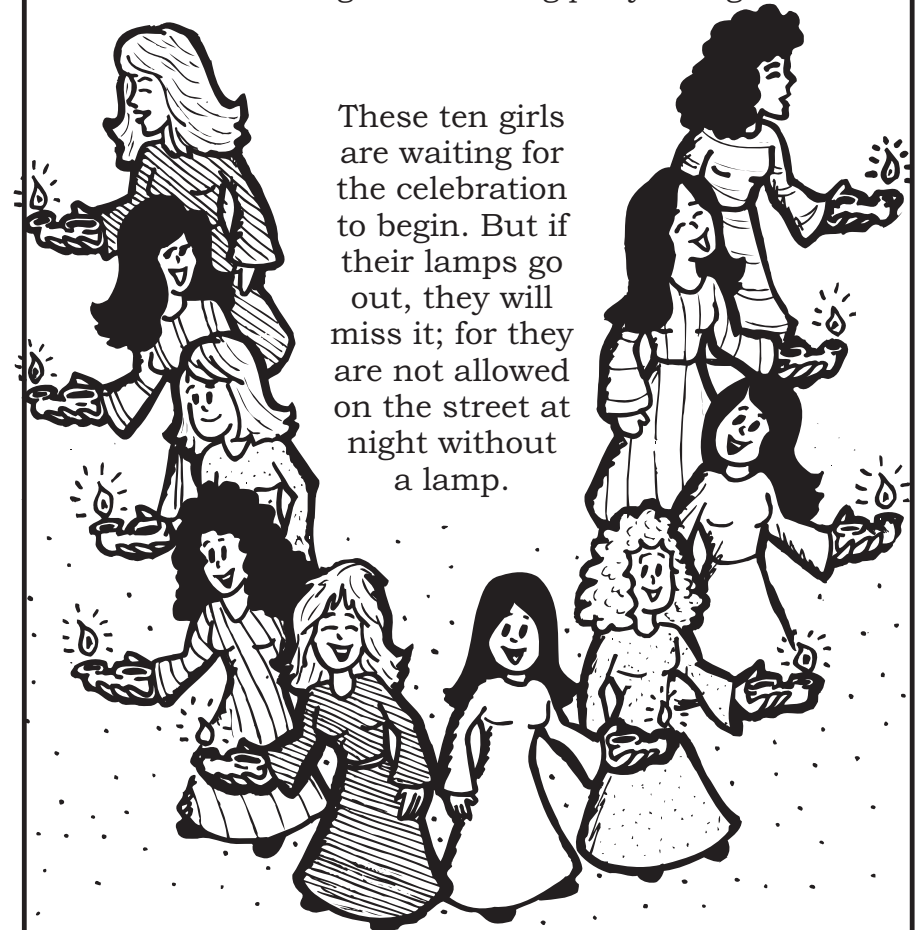
# Kidsword
