Pathways to Generosity Program (rescheduled from 1/25)



Dawn Hamill is a retired elder law attorney and a member of Calvin Presbyterian Church for the past 19 years. Her career spans from private practice wherein she assisted clients with their elder law needs, whether it was spending down to be Medicaid eligible, will contests of Guardianship matters to working for PNC Bank in their Wealth Management Division administering Irrevocable Trusts, IRA's and Investment Managed Accounts. Most recently she was tasked with managing Special Needs Trusts, Guardianships and Court Structured Settlement Trusts and the many legal issues that encompassed these various documents. Dawn will be discussing Last Wills and Testaments, Financial Powers of Attorney, Healthcare Powers of Attorney and Living Wills and the importance of having these documents in place as we age. As a retired attorney, she is prohibited from providing any advice during the discussion. Dawn can make referrals to qualified attorneys currently practicing in this field.

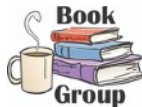
February 15 — Glenn Sanders

Jeremiah 18: 1-6 and Romans 9: 20-24

The Romans verses will be the First Nations Version of the New Testament. The focus will be on the potter, the clay, and the vessel being metaphors for our relationship both individually and as a community with God. By seeing the process of pot making and understanding what goes into that process, my hope is that we not only see God as the potter, but the importance of the Trinity being included in the metaphor of the potter. We may come to recognize God's people as both the clay and the clay vessels, and begin to understand where Jesus fits into the clay.

Feb 4 & 25

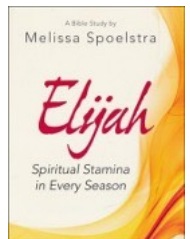
