

Calvin 2Gether:

- 1. **FIND:** someone you don't know as well as others and introduce yourself, or discuss with your family around the dinner table.
- 2. DISCUSS: What resurrection stories can you tell? Where have you witnessed people or communities being brought from death to life? Who serves as Tabitha in your faith community? Whose work keeps Calvin alive and well? What counter-cultural story does Calvin tell? Who is devalued by society that is valued at Calvin?
- 3. **PRAYER COVENANT:** to pray for each other daily, by name until you meet again (the prayer to the right is offered as a suggestion).
